

#### The Legal Driver for FRMPs






### Draft FRMPs – first cycle

- EA produce for main rivers, the sea and reservoirs
- LLFAs in 'flood risk areas' produce for local flood risk (non-main rivers, groundwater and surface water)
- Outside 'flood risk areas', contributing to a FRMP is voluntary



#### Flood Risk Areas


- PFRAs defined 'significant flood risk areas' for local flooding
- 10 in England
- Gtr Manchester
- Liverpool & Sefton





#### Core information for each RBD

- ◆ Flood risk: maps and statistics
- Conclusions about flood risk: narrative
- Objectives: social, environmental, economic
- Measures: prevention, protection, preparedness, recovery and review






#### FRMPs and RBMPs .....


- Bring together existing info' on the water environment and on flood risk management
