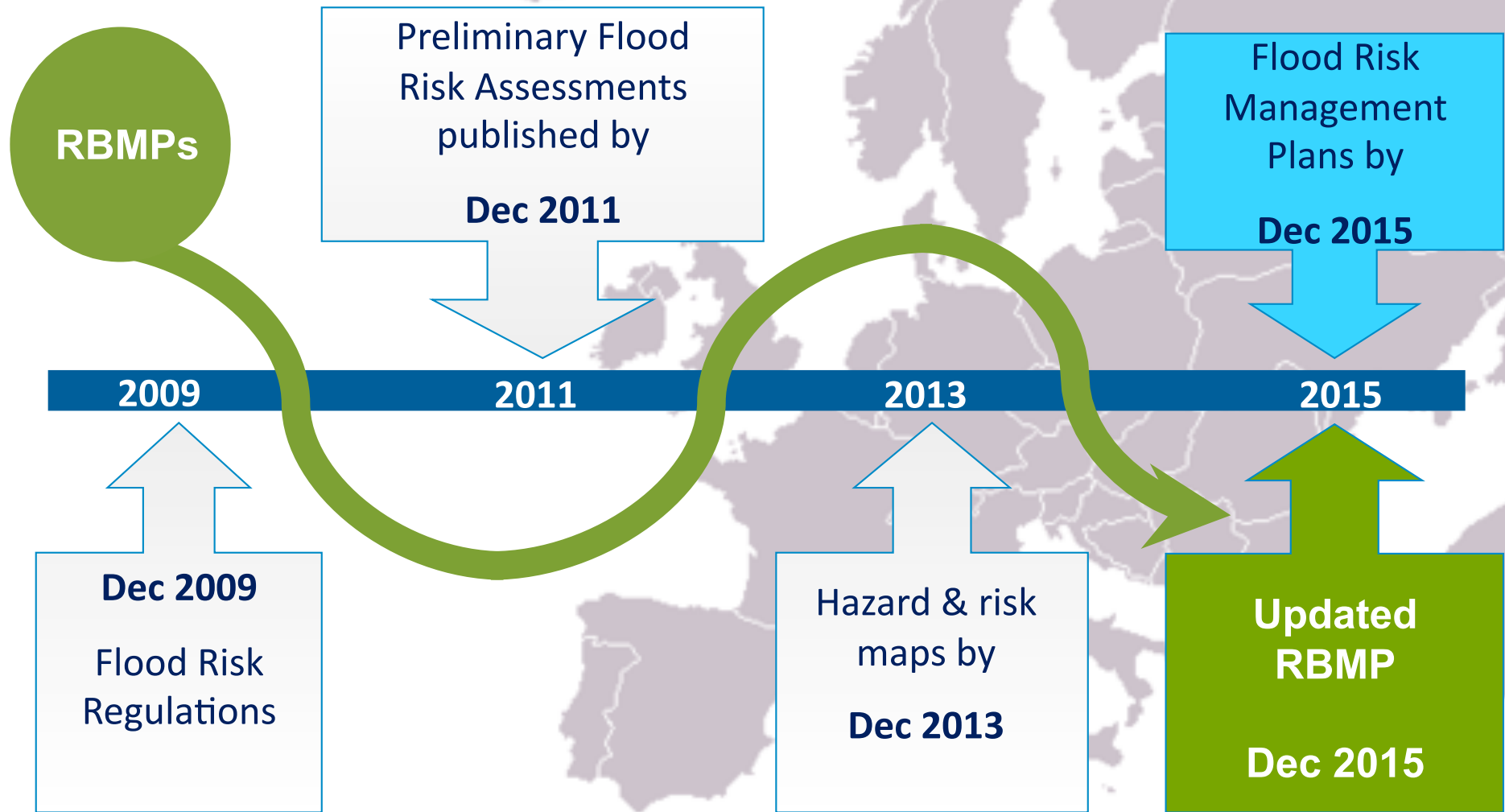

The Legal Driver for FRMPs

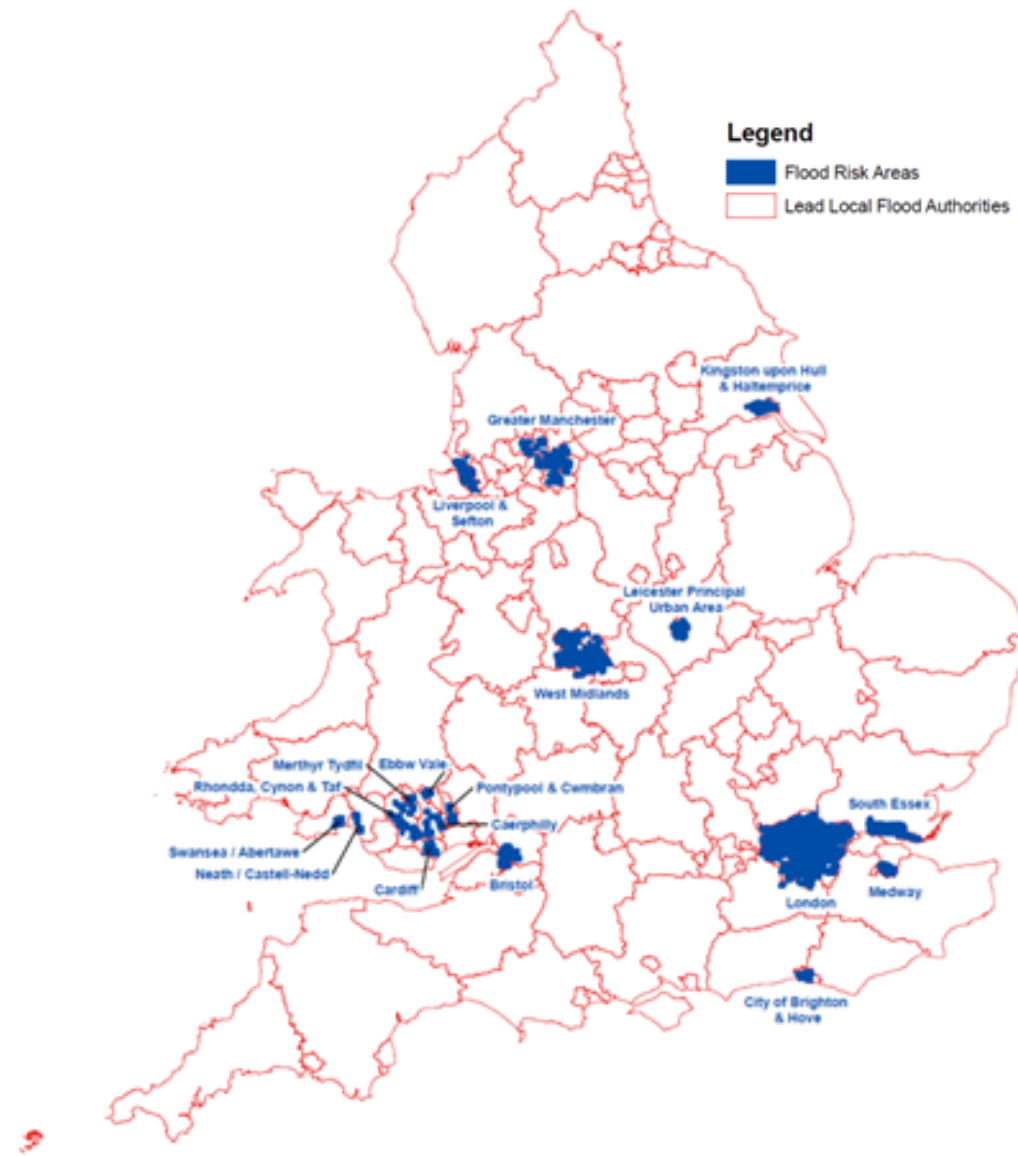


Draft FRMPs – first cycle

- ➔ EA produce for main rivers, the sea and reservoirs
- ➔ LLFAs in ‘flood risk areas’ produce for local flood risk (non-main rivers, groundwater and surface water)
- ➔ Outside ‘flood risk areas’, contributing to a FRMP is voluntary

Flood Risk Areas

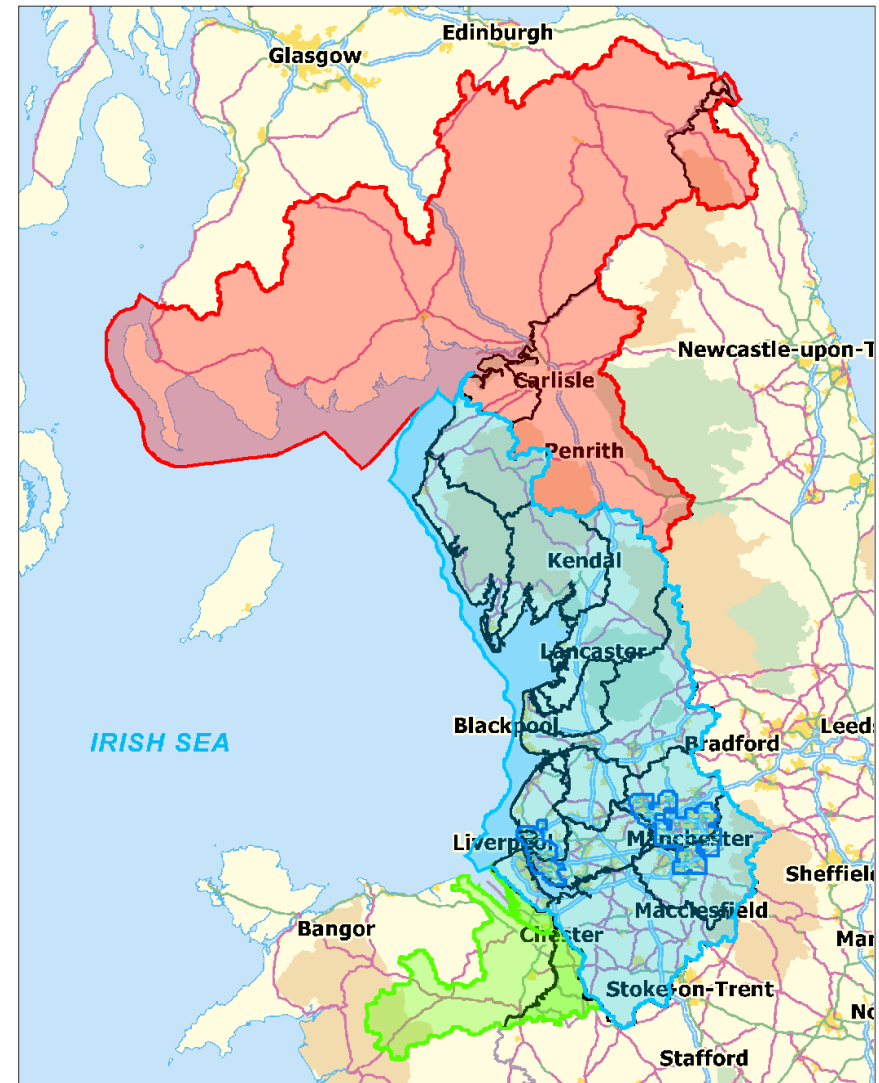
- ➔ PFRAs defined 'significant flood risk areas' for local flooding
- ➔ 10 in England
- ➔ Gtr Manchester
- ➔ Liverpool & Sefton



Core information for each RBD

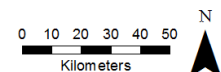
- ➔ Flood risk: maps and statistics
- ➔ Conclusions about flood risk: narrative
- ➔ Objectives: social, environmental, economic
- ➔ Measures: prevention, protection, preparedness, recovery and review

- Flood Risk Areas

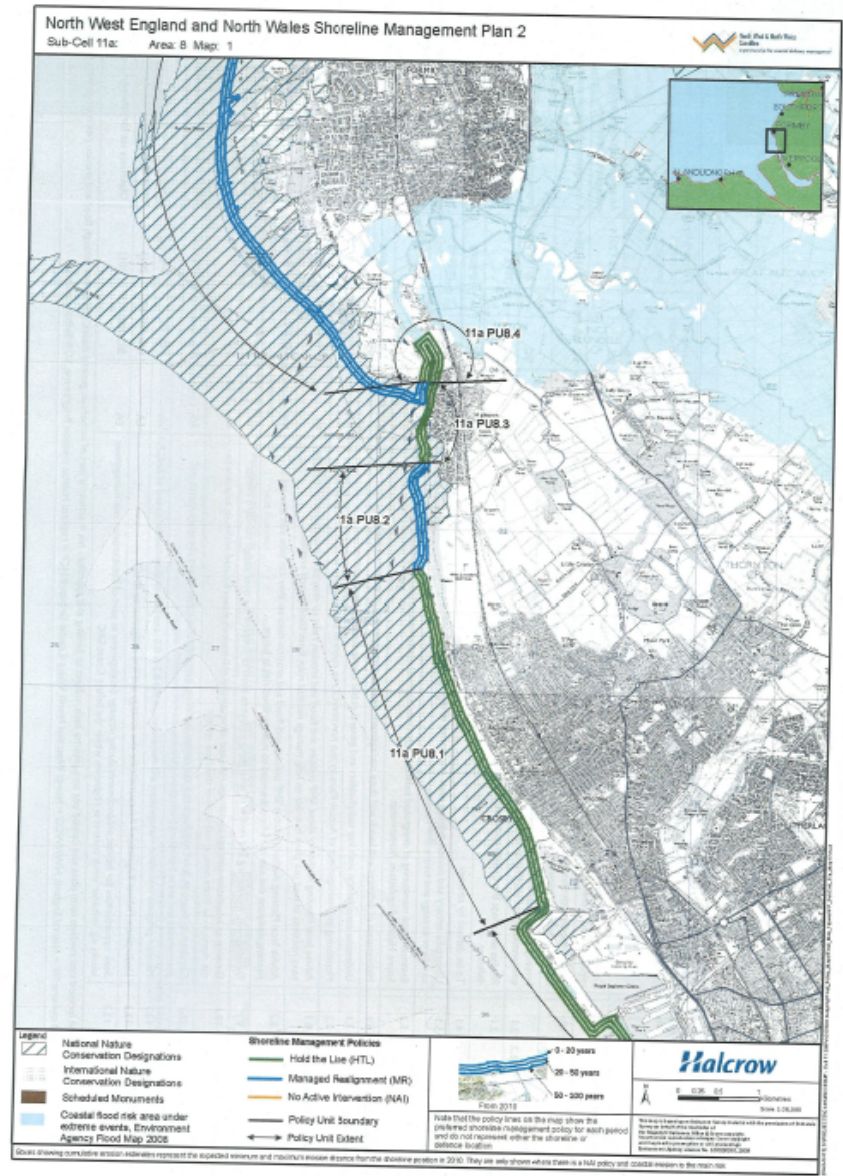
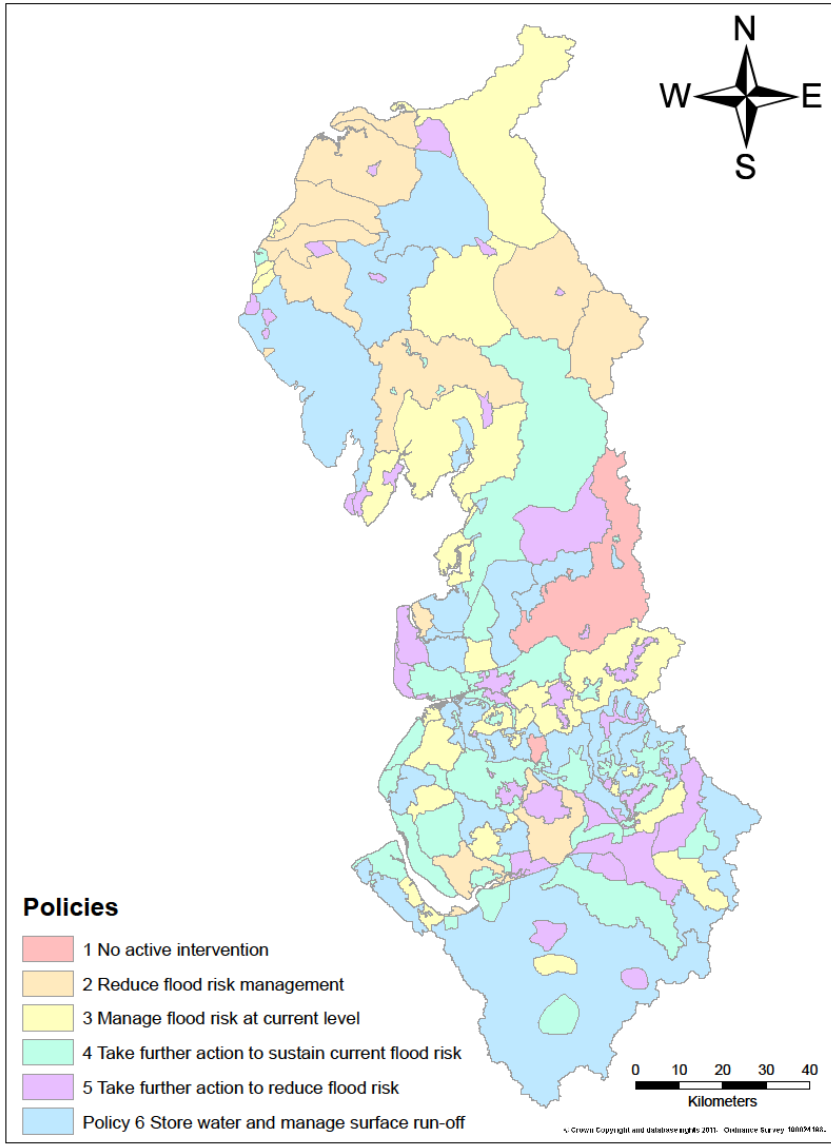

- ➔ Bring together existing info' on the water environment and on flood risk management
- ➔ Draw on:
 - ➔ 12 CFMPs, 2008
 - ➔ 1 Shoreline Mgt. Plan, 2010
 - ➔ 23 Local Strategies – ongoing?
- ➔ Opportunities to agree common priorities and work programmes for flood risk and enviroent.
- ➔ Will direct significant action and funding between 2016 to 2021 and beyond
