
About CLASP



- A home for innovation and ideas







What we've achieved

- We've supported some "firsts" in UK climate change action:
 - A 3D model to help rural communities plan and act towards a sustainable energy future
 - A process for developing Ward and Super Output Area climate change adaptation plans
 - A code of practice for solid wall insulation installers
 - Changes to park management practices to make parks more resilient and more valuable in a changing climate
 - Development of business models for carbon brokerage schemes incentivising carbon sequestration through land management

- Developed policies and strategies to embed sustainability in the future of local areas and services
- Leveraged in funding for energy efficiency, district heating, renewable energy, climate resilience and flood risk management projects
- Invested with local businesses to deliver these projects


