Early definition

"An ESCO, or Energy Service Company, is a business that develops, installs, and arranges financing for projects designed to improve the energy efficiency and maintenance costs for facilities over a seven to twenty year time period. "

(National Association of Energy Services Companies - US)

Evolving definitions in the UK

- Energy <u>Service</u> Company to Energy <u>Services</u> Company
- No-longer single building operator based
- Not just energy efficiency
- Not necessarily arranging finance, developing and installing projects

ESCos and MUSCos

 ESCo - energy focused (efficiency/renewable/affordable/low carbon)

 MUSCo (Multi-utility Service Company) – energy + water + waste + comms +.....+

How do ESCos differ from traditional energy companies?

	Energy Company	ESCo
Primary purpose	Return profit on investment	Environmental and social benefits (as well as financial)
Scope	Generating, distributing and selling energy	Generating, distributing and selling energy, promoting energy efficiency, tackling fuel poverty, carbon reduction/renewable energy objectives, O&M
Structure	Plc FTSE listed	SPV/JV/Co. Ltd by Guarantee/CIC etc
Scale	Scottish and Southern Energy Turnover : £25 billion 17,000 employees	Annual turnover £million? Less than 30 employees
Territory	Multi-regional/national	Single development/town/city
Origins	Nationalised companies/investor- owned, growth through mergers/acquisitions	Established by public sector/JV/PFI
